# WELCOME TO 2024 PUDASJÄRVI SUMMER SERVICES!

The annual SRK Summer Services are held this year in Pudasjärvi from June 28th to July 1st, 2024. The motto for the Summer Services is "Do you love me?" (John 21:17). This question was posed by Jesus to Peter on the shore of the Sea of Galilee after His resurrection. The same question is also directed to each of us: "Do you love me?"

The venue for the Summer Services is the Pudasjärvi Airport, owned by the City of Pudasjärvi. The last time the Summer Services were held at Pudasjärvi Airport was in 2013. The area has been developed in collaboration with the city to better serve as a venue for this significant gathering. Pudasjärvi is located in the northern part of the North Ostrobothnia region, approximately 100 kilometers northeast of Oulu and southwest of Kuusamo. The town has a population of around 7,600 residents.

The organizing responsibility lies with the following RYs (Associations of Peace): Kuusamo, Jakkukylä, Kiiminki, Posio, Pudasjärvi, Ranua, Taivalkoski, Ylikiihinki, and Yli-Ii. The primary responsibility for the Summer Services lies with the Kuusamo RY.

Our prayer is that God would bless the arrangements for these services. We ask that God's Word would call people into His kingdom and refresh the listeners' souls during the Pudasjärvi Summer Services in 2024.

## SUMMER SERVICES

Suviseurat, Summer Services, is an annual event arranged in cooperation with the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Finland. It is the largest spiritual event in the Nordic countries, with about 75,000 participants. Service guests arrive each year from over 30 different countries. Suviseurat, Summer Services, have been arranged since 1906.

The service program primarily consists of sermons and Songs and Hymns of Zion. Meeting friends and acquaintances is of great significance as well. The sermons are about God's love and mercy towards a sinful person. The sermons teach that when a person believes their sins forgiven, they attain peace in their hearts and are assured an everlasting foundation for their life of faith based on the redemption works of the Lord Jesus Christ. At the center of the service site is a large, open gathering place and a service tent in which the sermons are preached and liturgy is officiated. The tent seats 4000 listeners.

A Sunday morning worship service is held in many nearby churches. Holy Communion is served in the service tent, with about 70 clergymen officiating. Sermons and singing are broadcast through loudspeakers placed over the entire service site, on which the greater portion of service guests are lodged in travel trailers, motorhomes, and tents. Sermons are interpreted into nine different languages. The entire summer service site is like a self-sustaining medium-size city with all necessary conveniences, goods, and services.

All of this is provided by volunteer labor. Suomen Rauhanyhdistysten Keskusyhdistys (SRK), Finland's Central Organization of Associations of Peace, serves as the umbrella organization for 178 registered Associations of Peace (RYs). The SRK serves and supports the activities of its member organizations. ## HOW WE BELIEVE

Here, the Communion is served by dipping the bread into wine (intinction practice). Exit the tent through doorways 7–12.

Individuals with limited mobility should go to Communion through entrances 8 and 11.

Additional Information: Communion will continue in the main tent until approximately 8:30 PM. The conclusion of serving of Communion will be announced separately. The Communion service will conclude according to the liturgical order. The Communion bread is gluten-free, and non-alcoholic wine is available upon request at all tables.

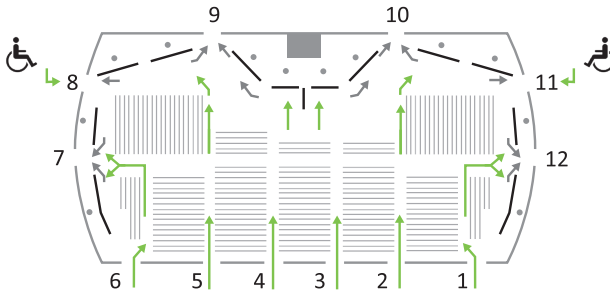
